TRACK REQUIRMENTS - WILLOWBANK

- Licensing** The minimum Licence required is a D grade competition licence.
- Karts** *Must conform to the current Australian Karting Association manual i.e.; in race ready condition.....even for practice.
- Driver**
- *Full face type helmet with Australian Standards as per AKA manual
 - *One piece full length suit – Zip-up
 - *Full protection gloves
 - *Boots covering the ankles

Your first meeting?

This general guide may help you through it.

Listed below is a rough guide to help you through your first race meeting. We hope it will be of some help and if you have questions that are not answered on this sheet, then feel free to ask any official on race day or contact the Club's Secretary.

1. Make sure you have your licence / Smart Card or if you have not been issued with your licence / Smart Card you may provide your pink slip but please check with the entry office before you set up for the day.
2. Your nomination and paperwork should have been completed and sent in to the Race Secretary or pre-nominated the day before. If not immediately go to the Entry office and check to see that entries are still being taken.
3. Arrive giving yourself approx. 1 hour before official practice.
4. Make sure to have collected your Transponder from the Entry Office before you head out onto the track.
5. Unload and set up your pit area. NOTE: Covered pits are rented from the Club on a yearly basis. If you don't "own" a covered bay then your pit area is located at the rear of the pits – you may erect your own shade cover or race day bay's are available for rent.
6. Take your kart and race equipment (licence/Smart Card/helmet etc) to the Scrutineer. This is for safety/legality check.
7. Prepare for practice – you will get approx 10 mins. Seniors, Juniors and Rookies/Midgets have separate sessions.
8. Attend the drivers briefing – COMPULSORY for drivers and Pit Crews.
9. Licenses for upgrading are to be requested at the Entry Office when nominating. If you complete your race meet without any problems, your upgrade will be processed through the AKA System.
10. Prepare for your first – for most of us this includes a quick visit to the toilet.
